### **Official Terms and Conditions for the Aston Martin Aramco F1 Team Three Sixty surveys and the associated competitions (“Competitions”) (together the “Three Sixty Programme”)**

The Promoter of the Three Sixty Programme is AMR GP Limited (“**Promoter**”) whose registered address is at Dadford Road, Silverstone, Towcester, Northamptonshire, NN12 8 TJ, United Kingdom.

The Administrator of the Three Sixty Programme is Potentia Insight (“**Administrator**”), whose registered address is at 1 Scholars Walk, Chalfont St. Peter, Gerrards Cross, Bucks, England, SL9 0EJ.

By electing to participate in the Three Sixty Programme, participants will be deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions (“**Three Sixty Terms and Conditions**”) and hereby agree to be bound by them when participating in the Three Sixty Programme.

The Three Sixty Programme is in no way endorsed by Facebook, Google and/or any other social media channel.

#### **1. Participation in the Three Sixty Programme**

- (a) The Three Sixty Programme is open to all persons aged eighteen (18) years and over.
- (b) Membership to the Three Sixty Programme is free.
- (c) Where operation of the Three Sixty Programme is not permitted by applicable law or regulation of the country in which the participant normally resides and/or is entering from, the Three Sixty Programme (including any Surveys and/or Competitions) shall not be operated in such jurisdictions and its residents shall not be permitted to enter. By participating in the Three Sixty Programme, participants warrant and represent that their participation (and winning of any Prize – as defined in paragraphs 2(d),(f) and (h) below) shall not breach or render the Promoter or the Administrator in breach of any applicable law, regulation or requirement to pay any taxes, in the country in which the participant normally resides and/or has entered from. Notwithstanding the previous sentence, persons shall not be eligible to participate from the following countries or states: (i) Abu Dhabi, Austria, Belarus, Brazil, Chile, Columbia, Hong Kong, Philippines, United Arab Emirates; and (ii) any country subject to US or UK sanctions. Consequently the Promoter may remove and/or block any and all participants from such jurisdictions; in the event that any participant from one of the aforementioned jurisdictions participates in the Three Sixty Programme and wins a Prize in error, such entrant shall indemnify the Promoter (and the Administrator where applicable) in full and on demand and shall return the Prize (as defined below) and take all other actions as reasonably required by the Promoter and/or the Administrator to obviate their entry (at their own cost).
- (d) Registration is limited to one (1) per participant and multiple accounts are not permitted. If a participant is found to have multiple accounts, all linked accounts shall be removed from the site.
- (e) By registering as a member of the Three Sixty Programme, participants agree to receive invitations to participate in marketing surveys conducted by the Promoter (“**Surveys**”) and facilitated by the Administrator.

- (f) The Promoter and the Administrator reserve the right to ask for proof of age and verify the identity of any participant in a Survey and/or winner of a Prize. Accordingly, participants shall provide such reasonable documentary evidence as the Promoter and/or Administrator shall specify in order to verify the age and identity of the relevant participant.
- (g) Only participants selected by the Promoter (at its sole and unfettered discretion) to participate in the Three Sixty Programme shall receive invitations to participate in the Surveys. In joining the Three Sixty Programme participants agree that there is no guarantee that they will be accepted to participate in the Surveys.
- (h) By participating in the Three Sixty Programme, participants may be eligible to win prizes pursuant to a Competition. Participants agree that such prizes are not guaranteed and shall be awarded pursuant to the terms and conditions set out in paragraph 3.
- (i) The Promoter and the Administrator ensure they are providing quality data to any participants in the Three Sixty Programme, therefore any data received from the Surveys is reviewed and quality verified. If your responses do not pass quality verification you will not be eligible for a Prize. Quality verification includes but is not limited to false, Nonsensical or inappropriate responses and/or responses lacking depth or insight;
- (j) Participants agree that failure to pass quality verification or completing a Survey more than once may cause them to face removal from the Three Sixty Programme;
- (k) Participants can unsubscribe from Three Sixty Programme at any time, by using the unsubscribe link found on the bottom of any of the Promoter's E-mail communication with the Participant. Any information in the Three Sixty Programme identifiable as that participants will be permanently deleted. The Promoter reserves the right to terminate a participant's account at any time.

## 2. Competition Eligibility and Entry Criteria

- (a) Only participants selected by the Promoter to participate in the Three Sixty Programme pursuant to paragraph 1(g) shall be eligible to participate in a Competition.
- (b) Each Competition shall be a game of skill. Chance plays no part in determining the winner of each Competition. Each entry shall be individually judged based upon the individual creative merit to the answer of the final question in each survey which will have a skill element
- (c) Employees of the Promoter or Administrator, or their family members or anyone else connected in any way to a Competition or to the Three Sixty Programme shall not be permitted to participate in any Competition.
- (d) All participants that have been elected to participate in the Three Sixty Programme by the Promoter in accordance with paragraph 1(g) within the first fourteen (14) days from the official launch date of the Three Sixty Programme shall be eligible to participate in a Competition ("**Initial Competition**") to win one (1) tour of the Aston Martin Aramco Technology Campus (excluding all travel and accommodation costs) ("**Initial Prize**").
- (e) On 23 February 2026, twenty (20) winners of the Initial Competition shall be selected by the Promoter from all valid and eligible entries and each winner shall win one (1) Initial Prize.
- (f) At the end of each calendar month for the duration of the Three Sixty Programme (or until such earlier date as selected by the Promoter), the participants that have been elected to participate in the Three Sixty Programme by the Promoter in accordance with paragraph 1(g), shall be eligible to participate in a Competition ("**Monthly Competition**") to win one (1) piece of signed Aston Martin Aramco Formula One Team merchandise ("**Monthly Prize**").
- (g) On the last business day of each month for the duration of the Three Sixty Programme, three (3) winners of the Monthly Competition shall be selected by the Promoter from all valid and eligible entries and each winner shall win one (1) Monthly Prize.
- (h) In December of each calendar year for the duration of the Three Sixty Programme (or until such earlier date as selected by the Promoter), the participants that have been elected to participate in the Three Sixty Programme by the Promoter in accordance with paragraph 1(g), shall be eligible to participate in a Competition ("**Annual Competition**") to win one (1) pair of

tickets to an Aston Martin Aramco Formula One Team weekend experience the following (“**Annual Prize**”).

- (i) On 1 December of each calendar year for the duration of the Three Sixty Programme, one (1) winner of the Annual Competition shall be selected by the Promoter from all valid and eligible entries and that winner shall win the Annual Prize.
- (j) Each winner of an Initial Prize, a Monthly Prize or an Annual Prize (each a “**Prize**” and together the “**Prizes**”) (subject to subsequent verification of their details and/or a security check) will be notified by mail using the contact details submitted within fourteen (14) days of the date on which the winners of each applicable Competition are selected by the Promoter in accordance with paragraphs 2(e), (g) and (i). Participants must ensure they check their spam/bulk/junk folders and ensure the relevant account remains active in order to avoid missing the notification as neither the Promoter nor the Administrator shall be liable in the event that any notification is not received by a winning participant in such circumstances.
- (k) Subject to paragraph 2(l), each winner shall have fourteen (14) days to respond from the date upon which they are notified by the Promoter that they have won a Competition to claim their Prize.
- (l) If a winner does not or is not able, for any reason, to claim or accept a Prize (by the relevant deadlines set out in paragraph 2(k)), or cannot be contacted within fourteen (14) days of the relevant draw date, the Promoter reserves the right to award the Prize to another participant and the previous winning entrant waives all claims against the Promoter and the Administrator (in respect of the applicable Prize Draw or otherwise).

### **3. Prizes**

- (a) For the avoidance of doubt, unless explicitly included within the definition of the Prizes set out in paragraphs 2(d),(f) and (h), other constituent elements which might, by implication, be included within that definition are excluded.
- (b) Following a response from each winner in accordance with paragraph 2(k), the Promoter shall make arrangements with such winner for delivery of the Prize. Each Prize shall be delivered at the Promoter’s cost to the relevant winner’s address (time and date to be mutually agreed by the relevant winner and the Promoter). The Promoter has discretion as to which method of delivery to use. Each winner is responsible for ensuring that he/she is able to take delivery of their Prize on the arranged delivery date/time slot and the Promoter reserves the right to require the relevant winner to pay for any additional delivery time slots if the initial slot is missed. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, neither the Promoter, nor the Administrator shall have any liability in respect of any failure of any delivery service to deliver any Prize to a winner and the Promoter’s written confirmation of its despatch of the Prize to the relevant winner shall be final and not subject to any appeal and/or other form of recourse.
- (c) The Promoter reserves the right to amend, vary and/or substitute the Prizes (or any part of them) for a prize or prizes of equivalent or greater monetary value (as quantified by the Promoter) if this is necessary for reasons beyond its control.
- (d) There is no cash alternative to the Prizes (or any part of them) and unless agreed otherwise in writing, the Prizes are non-refundable, non-transferable and cannot be sold or given away by the winner.
- (e) Third party terms and conditions may apply to parts of the Prizes in certain cases. Each winner undertakes to comply with all such terms and conditions and neither the Promoter, nor the Administrator, shall be responsible for any failure to comply with such terms and conditions by the relevant winner. In particular, the winners shall comply with all health and safety guidelines and instructions and all applicable legal and regulatory requirements.

### **4. Personal Data and Publicity and Intellectual Property**

- (a) The Promoter and Administrator will use personal information about participants for the purpose of operating the Three Sixty Programme (including, but not limited to, the collection of any data received through any Survey and the administration of any Prize) in accordance with the Promoter's Privacy Policy (which can be found [here](#)) and the Administrator's Privacy Policy (which can be found [here](#)) ("**Privacy Policies**"). By participating in the Three Sixty Programme, each participant agrees that the Promoter and Administrator may collect and use his/her personal information in accordance with the Privacy Policies. Each participant agrees that he/she has read the Privacy Policies.
- (b) The Promoter and its business partners may also use the details provided by participants to contact participants for marketing purposes by email – details of which are further set out in the Promoter's Privacy Policy.
- (c) Participants acknowledge and agree that their data may be processed outside of the European Economic Area, and by entering this Three Sixty Programme, participants consent to this.
- (d) Participants agree that by participating in the Three Sixty Programme, they grant the Promoter an irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free licence (i.e. permission) for the Promoter and its agents and licensees to edit, publish, broadcast and otherwise use any videos, photographs and/or digital content arising from or out of any Prize the participant may win pursuant to their participation in the Three Sixty Programme for any and all purposes in any and all media throughout the world in perpetuity (or, where such a licence is not lawful or enforceable, for up to 5 years from the date of the last Survey the participant participates in), including, without limitation, on the Promoter's publicly accessible website(s), social channels and all other media whether now known or hereafter invented.
- (e) Participants agree that they shall not publicise that they have participated in the Three Sixty Programme and/or won a Prize (where applicable) and/or give any interviews without the Promoter's prior written consent.
- (f) Participants acknowledge that all materials on the Surveys, including the design, graphics, text, sounds, pictures, software and any other file included within the Surveys (collectively, "**Materials**") are the property of the Promoter and/or the Administrator and are subject to and protected by the law of England and Wales and international copyright and any other intellectual property laws and rights that may apply.

## 5. Liability

- (a) So far as is permitted by law and subject to paragraph 5(d), the Promoter, the Administrator and their associated companies and agents exclude responsibility and all liabilities arising from:
  - a. any postponement or cancellation of the Three Sixty Programme and/or to any Competition;
  - b. any changes to, supply of (including, without limitation, prizes which do not reach the intended recipient), or use of the Prizes;
  - c. entries that are submitted from jurisdictions in which this Three Sixty Programme and any Competition is rendered unlawful; and
  - d. any act or default of any third party,which are beyond the Promoter's reasonable control.
- (b) The Prizes may comprise of automotive parts and/or accessories. In such instances, for the avoidance of doubt, such Prizes will constitute standalone parts or accessories only and should not be used by in conjunction with and/or attached to any vehicle. The Promoter shall not be liable for any death or personal injury caused by non-compliance with this paragraph 5(b) or the remainder of these Three Sixty Terms and Conditions.
- (c) Neither the Promoter nor the Administrator accepts responsibility for network, computer, hardware or software failures of any kind (including unavailability of email providers or any social network), which may restrict or delay the sending, receipt or processing of your

participation or for responses to Surveys which are lost, damaged, delayed or unreadable except as a result of the Promoter's or Administrator's negligence. Responses to Surveys must not be sent in through agents or third parties. Incomplete responses, and participants and responses which do not satisfy the requirements of these Three Sixty Terms and Conditions, will be disqualified and will not be counted.

- (d) Nothing in these Three Sixty Terms and Conditions in any way limit the Promoter, the Administrator (or any other person or organisation's) liability for (i) fraud, or (ii) death or personal injury caused by negligence.
- (e) You agree to indemnify the Promoter and the Administrator in respect of third party claims arising out of or in connection with any breach by you of these Three Sixty Terms and Conditions or any use by you of the Prizes.

## **6. General**

- (a) Participation in the Three Sixty Programme (including the response to any Surveys) must not be created or generated using Artificial Intelligence ("AI"), any participant deemed by the Promoter or the Administrator to be using AI shall be disqualified from the Prize Draw and removed from the Three Sixty Programme.
- (b) The Promoter's decisions relating to the Three Sixty Programme (including, without limitation, to any Competition) shall be final and binding in all respects; no correspondence will be entered into. Participants that do not comply in full with these Three Sixty Terms and Conditions may be disqualified.
- (c) Participants will be disqualified from the Three Sixty Programme (including, without limitation, all Competitions) if, in the reasonable opinion of the Promoter or the Administrator, the participant has:
  - a. breached these Three Sixty Terms and Conditions;
  - b. has conducted themselves in an inappropriate manner contrary to the spirit and intention of the Three Sixty Programme;
  - c. has committed or undertaken any acts for fraud, misconduct, dishonesty and/or provided false information.
- (d) The Promoter may disqualify any participant that the Promoter believes such participants participation in the Three Sixty Programme (including any Competition) may cause harm to the Promoter's reputation and/or bring the Promoter into disrepute and/or otherwise cause any negative press coverage (including on social media).
- (e) If the Promoter or Administrator have grounds to suspect any participant or third party of cheating, deception, criminal, fraudulent or unsportsman-like conduct of any kind, the Promoter reserves the right (in its sole discretion) to disqualify the participant from the Three Sixty Programme (including any Competition).
- (f) Each participant agrees that, in the event he/she becomes a winner of a Competition, he/she shall execute (within a reasonable timeframe) such additional obligations and/or documentation as may be specified by the Promoter in relation to the Prize.
- (g) The Promoter may add to, amend or vary these Three Sixty Terms and Conditions from time to time, at its discretion without prior notice. Any changes will be posted via these Three Sixty Terms and Conditions.
- (h) This Three Sixty Programme (and all Competitions) and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it (including all non-contractual disputes), shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law. By participating in the Three Sixty Programme (including, participating in the Competitions) all participants irrevocably agree that the courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this Three Sixty Programme (including all Competitions).
