

EVENT SUSTAINABILITY

Purpose and Scope

This is the Event Sustainability Policy Statement for AMR Performance Group Limited and its subsidiaries ("The AMR Group"). It is owned by the Chief People Officer and sets out our commitment to sustainable development across events hosted at the Aston Martin Racing Technology Campus.

Vision

Make A Mark is our commitment to driving positive progress for people, planet and partners, with accountability and respect by channelling a high-performance mindset to deliver lasting positive impact.

Commitment

The AMR Group commits to:

- Preventing pollution and protecting the environment.
- Meeting applicable legal and other compliance obligations relating to environmental protection, sustainability and energy performance.
- Applying a risk-based approach to sustainable event management.
- Continual improvement of the event sustainability management system.

Ambition

The AMR Group are adopting an ambitious sustainable development strategy for 2026 and beyond with three specific aims:

- Improve climate resilience and reduce our carbon footprint by implementing decarbonisation measures.
- Promote energy conservation through increased use of renewable technology and energy-efficient products.
- Optimise resource management through sustainable procurement and circular economy principles.

Achievement of these aims will be supported through collaboration with key stakeholders, including strategic partners and suppliers, the FIA and Formula One™, alongside the continual development and implementation of environmental solutions.

Responsibilities

Overall accountability for event sustainability management at the AMR Group sits with the leadership team and is overseen by the Chief People Officer.

The Chief People Officer holds the People Performance Manager and ESG Director accountable for all aspects of event sustainability management in the business.

Roles, responsibilities and authorities relevant to, event sustainability management are defined, communicated and maintained within the business.

All individuals working for or on behalf of the AMR Group are expected to comply with this policy and contribute to its effective implementation.

Approach

- Maintain an ISO 20121-aligned event sustainability management system, resourced appropriately and integrated with other relevant management systems where practicable.
- Apply a risk-based approach to identify requirements and impacts, ensuring compliance with applicable legal and other compliance obligations.
- Ensure competence, awareness and effective communication with relevant stakeholders to support sustainable event delivery.
- Monitor, measure and report sustainable event performance to drive continual improvement.

Review

This policy shall be reviewed on an annual basis and as and when necessary to reflect changes in relevant legislation.
